Climate change: How to be more eco-friendly in everyday life

With UK summers projected to hit 45°C by 2050, cutting fossil emissions has never been more urgent. Solar is the fastest, most cost-effective way to slash carbon, stabilise energy costs and build real climate resilience. It's a smart upgrade that protects budgets and the communities you serve from the extreme heat ahead.

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How solar helps prevent extreme 45°C summers

Solar power can reduce extreme UK heat by cutting fossil-fuel emissions that drive global warming. Greenhouse gases raise temperatures, potentially making UK summers up to 6°C hotter.

Replacing gas-fired electricity with clean solar energy lowers CO₂ emissions, helping limit warming to 1.5–2°C and reducing the likelihood of 40–45°C heatwaves. Although solar cannot stop climate change alone, it is a fast, scalable way to reduce emissions and future extreme temperatures.

What Have We Been Up To Lately?

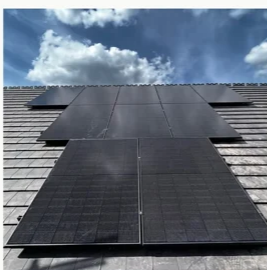
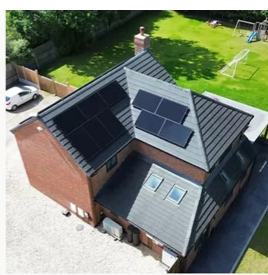
Net0 Plus recently met with our local MP, Alex Brewer, to discuss our fully funded solar solution for the public sector.

Our aim is simple: to help supply and install solar systems and air conditioning for schools across the UK, using finance options that allow the Government or local authorities to own the systems and keep the long-term financial benefits.

With funding partners already able to support projects at scale, this approach could help bring the UK closer to net zero sooner, without sacrificing valuable green spaces.

Compared with leasehold PPA agreements, we believe this model has the potential to keep billions of pounds within local communities while delivering significant environmental savings.

Alex is now taking the proposal to the House of Commons for Government consideration, and we're excited to see how this important project develops.



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
